School Infrastructure NSW will partner with Multiplex, through a memorandum of understanding, detailing the highest standard of construction quality for educational infrastructure projects in NSW.

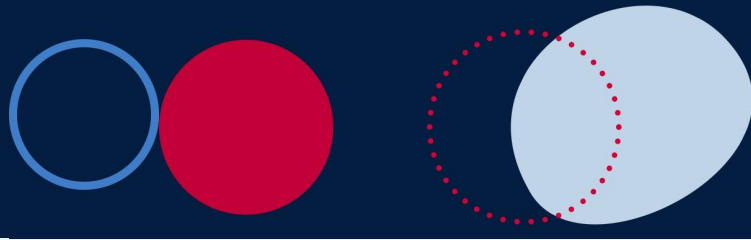
